Bombay Sapphire London Dry (40%) 3.40

The 10 botanicals used are held separate from the spirit in perforated copper baskets, and when the heat vapour rises, the distinctive flavour of the botanicals are released. One of the only gins to use vapour infusion.

Tanqueray Export Strength London Dry (43.1%) 3.60

Distilled 4 times for purity. Founded in 1830 by Charles Tanqueray and still distilled in London.

Hendrick's (41.4%) 3.60

Small batch handcrafted gin using traditional botanicals.+ Distilled in Scotland by William Grant & Sons famous for distilling whiskey.

Plymouth (41.2%) 3.60

Plymouth Original Strength is a unique, protected style of gin originating from the city of Plymouth, South West England. Since 1793 it has been distilled from a blend of 7 botanicals, soft Dartmoor water and pure grain alcohol at the historic Black Friars Distillery - the oldest working distillery in England.

The Lakes Gin (43.7%) 3.60

Crafted by our friends at The Lakes Distillery using water from the River Derwent and lakeside botanicals including Bilberry, Heather and Meadowsweet. This light and refreshing artisan Gin is 'big' with clear fresh citrus notes leaving it both fruity and floral.

Martin Miller's England Iceland London Dry (40%) 3.90

Made to a traditional London Dry Style in flavour profile and dryness, this gin uses a mix of ultra traditional distilling methods allied to Martin's own iconoclastic 'take' on gin distilling. In a break with tradition, there are two separate distillations for the juniper and earthier botanicals that are later 'married' or blended with a second separate distillation of the citrus elements of bitter orange peel from Seville, lemon and lime peel. These techniques contribute to the gin's unique freshness and clarity of flavour.

Beefeater 24 London Dry (45%) 3.90

Crafted by Master Distiller Desmond Payne, the most experienced gin distiller in the world, Beefeater 24 is developed over 18 months and receives feedback from some of the world's foremost mixologists. The result is a perfectly balanced, complex and sophisticated gin.

Hepple Gin (45%) 4.20

Named after the Village in Northumberland where it is made with the help of Valentine Warner. The gin is distilled with an ethos of focusing on the juniper berry while bringing in the savagely green, herbaceous moorland scents of Northumberland.

Sipsmith London Dry(41.6%) 4.20

A particularly dry gin with a zesty, citrus finish. The quintessential expression of a classic, traditional London Dry Gin. Bold, complex and aromatic. Distilled in the first copper still to launch in London for almost 200 years.
