

Scottish Whisky 25ml

Chivas Regal 12 (40%) 3.90

Wild herbs, heather, honey and orchard fruits on the nose, round and creamy on the palate, with a rich taste of ripe, honeyed apples and notes of vanilla, and butterscotch.

Glenmorangie Original (40%) 4.40

Citrus and ripe peaches on the nose, softened with a hint of vanilla. Vanilla on the tongue, bringing a burst of flowery fruitiness.

Glenfiddich 12 years old (40%) 4.40

The distillery's signature single malt Scotch whisky has matured for at least 12 years in American and Spanish oak casks. All are individually tended by experienced on-site coopers. The whisky develops complex, elegant flavours with notes of fresh pear and subtle oak.

Highland Park 12 years old (40%) 4.40

Medium bright gold in colour, a sweet 'come hither' nose with sherry and marzipan. Fruity, rich and sweet on the palate showing great depth. Smoky hints on the finish that fade gently into the background.

Johnny Walker Black Label (40%) 3.90

Robust and forceful, the peaty smoke is at the fore on the palate but also dried fruits sherry and vanilla. Never unbalanced – Power with discretion.

Isle of Jura Superstition (43%) 3.90

Deep bronze to the eye, this malt has a nose of wood smoke, bacon and freshly cut peat. Spice, honey pine and peat mingle on the palate with nuts and grassy/floral notes.

The MacAllan 10 Year Old (40%) 4.40

Deep natural colour from sherry cask ageing, the nose has immediate sweetness with malt and toffee. Full bodied malt but graceful and well balanced; a classic sherry finish where the sweetness comes through with citrus notes and hints of smoke and oak.

Caol Ila 12 Years Old (43%) 5.40

This little known distillery produces complex, smoky and oily-textured malts. This one has nuances of seaweed, juniper, olives and peaty dryness.

Laphroaig 10 years old (40%) 4.90

Best savoured neat, or with a little cool water. Roll it around on your tongue. Release the pungent, earthy aroma of blue peat smoke and the sweet nuttiness of the barley.

Lagavulin 16Years Old (43%) 8.20

Massive, peat-smoke typical of southern Islay, yet with a dry finesse that makes up a classy package. Apparently the teetotal Johnny Depp sometimes orders a dram of this and just sniffs it (it's that good). A worthy classic.

Talisker 10 Years Old (45.8%) 4.90

Surprises with some sweetness, then fruits, smoke and seaweed. Lots to give on the finish with the sweetness coming back and a distinctive sharp pepper bite. Good with oysters or smoked salmon.

Imported and Irish Whiskeys 25ml

Suntory Yamazaki 12 Year Old (Japan) (43%) 4.90

The number one single malt whisky in Japan, full bodied and floral on the nose but this gives way to sweet smoothness on the palate and citrus notes in the finish. This single malt has been a fixture in the boardrooms and bars of Japan since 1984.

Nikka Miyagikyo (Japan) (45%) 5.40

Crafted in Nikka's second Distillery in the mountains of Sendai. Nikka use less peaty malt and pot still using indirect steam to form a beautiful single malt which is light in body and yet full in flavour. This is the perfect entry into the rewarding world of Japanese Whisky.

Jamesons Irish Whiskey (Northern Ireland) (40%) 3.60

The nose offers an interesting combination of floral, orange, toffee, Sherry and spice notes. Water releases more cooked fruits and a suggestion of linseed. Initially citric in the mouth, along with classic Irish oiliness, more profound notes of Sherry develop, along with fudge, vanilla and spice. The finish is long, warming and spicy, remaining oily to the very end. Jameson is deservedly a world leader. Irish whiskey at its finest.

Original Old Bushmills (Northern Ireland) (40%) 3.50

The cornerstone of the Blackbush family, it's a blend of their own triple distilled malt whiskey with a lighter Irish grain whiskey. Making it an approachable whiskey with a rich' warming taste of fresh fruit and vanilla.

Bushmills Black Bush Special (Ireland) (40%) 3.90

A combination of a uniquely high proportion of malt whiskey matured in former Oloroso Sherry casks with a sweet, batch-distilled grain whiskey. This unique recipe gives Black Bush it's rich, fruity notes and intense character, balanced by a unique smoothness.

Jack Daniels Old No 7 (USA) (40%) 3.80

Tennessee whiskey is similar to bourbon but is different in that it is filtered through maple charcoal in large wooden vats prior to aging.

Tennessee whiskey is also not subject to the regulations relating to bourbons, such as the use of new barrels and low level of distilling proof.

Jim Beam (USA) (40%) 3.80

American as apple pie and a testament to quality, tradition and passion, Jim Beam® is the best-selling brand of bourbon in the world. Seven generations of craftsmanship go into every bottle, along with corn, rye, barley malt, water, time and pride.

Woodford Reserve (USA) (43.2%) 4.40

The colour of dark honey, this fine bourbon whiskey is rich and warming with layers of mint, tobacco, leather and fruit. Smooth and full-bodied. Has a slight sweetness to the European palate,

Maker's Mark (USA) (45%) 4.40

An amber coloured bourbon with spice and tropical fruits on the nose. Medium to full-bodied, with ginger spice, caramel and a mouth-watering oiliness of the palate.
